15/12-2        MINUTES

15/12-4        PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Ralph Tailford raised concerns over Hunsonby having several street lights, where as Winskill had very few. Chairman commented on general situation and that the light at Pleasant View was still awaiting completion.  
2 ladies from the committee Family fun for all – Winskill Playing field, spoke of the current progress of funding. The 2 events so far have raised £1744. Another event will be planned for Spring. 5 Grants have been approved from CCC, EDC Community Fund, Cumberland Building Society, Hadfield Trust, Pride in Penrith.

15/12-5a       CCC – Mary Robinson

Cllr Mary Robinson suggested other fund raisers might be available and to get in touch with her for further guidance. She said Langwathby Bridge would be re-opened for vehicle access either Thursday or Friday of this week, but definitely by the weekend. The Winskill street light (Alistairs Light) will be taken over by EDC as Eden Housing have declined to take this over.  
Mary suggested that we might like to “take over” a street light, some parish councils were extending their precept by £2or3000 to maintain one. We did not think this viable, as 3 villages could request keeping a light.

It was agreed unanimously by councillors to give the Winskill Playing Field project £1000, this was proposed by Alan Grave.  
Parish Land will be discussed at the next Parish Council meeting.

Winter Addis wondered whether we could have a grass box put in Little Salkeld playing field for grass cuttings. Nigel said his bill would increase by approx. 50% if he had to collect up the grass. Alan proposed we increase the grass cuts to 14 for Little Salkeld & Winskill playing fields next year which would mean less grass left lying. All councillors were in agreement with this proposal.  
The equipment in Little Salkeld playing field in need of repainting. This will be considered in the new year.
