19/03-4      PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mrs J Ulliyart advised the Winskill committee were applying for a further grant to install a see saw at the playground, the council had no problem with this. She also asked regarding the lighting in Winskill, as there is no light near the playground. Councillor advised the current situation with the lights.

It was also mentioned that Cumbria County Council are looking to cut the Bus Escorts on the 2 buses at Langwathby Primary school. An action group has been set up by various mums and they were looking for the support of the Parish Council. Clerk to email CCC to show support for this.

19/03-5      FIONA KNOX – NORTH PENNINES ANOB PARTNERSHIP

Fiona Knox gave a very interesting talk regarding the future plans for works at Long Meg involving the creation of a parking area. All the work is in connection with English Heritage as Long Meg is currently on the Risk register for national monuments. If approved the work would hopefully start in Spring 2020. Fiona also advised the council regarding the work that is to be carried out on the Lacy Caves walk following the damage done by Storm Desmond. The council fully supports any of the works.
