- 19/11-2 MINUTES
 The minutes of the meeting held on 18th September 2019 having been circulated, were signed as a correct record.

- 19/11-3 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

- 19/11-4 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION
 The chairman adjourned the meeting to allow the members of the public to speak. Mr B Gray advised work at the Community Centre committee has begun. Council advised the recycling bins are due to be removed at the end of the month. A member of the public wished to express her concern regarding the planning application in Little Salkeld. Chairman advised the application was due to be discussed later on in the meeting and her concerns would be noted.
- 19/11-4a EDC – D Banks
 Council currently on close down until after the election.
- 19/11-5 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES
 A dog fouling leaflet has been made up by local residents and posted through all doors, to try and curb the problem. Request made for another bin at the end of the swimming pool road, clerk to contact EDC.
 Play Park risk assessments have been done, some minor works are required. AST signs did the playground signs for Winskill, Little Salkeld also needs some.
 Email received from Lee Salmon regarding locked defib.
 2 plastic benches have been acquired from Penrith Town Council – need to think where they can go.
- 19/11-6 HUNSONBY RECYCLING CENTRE
 Clerk contacted Paul Emmerson at EDC to arrange the removal of the recycling bins from Hunsonby Community Centre at the request of the Community Centre Committee. Notices were placed on all notice boards to advise parishioners of this. Some concerns have been received at the loss. Council to wait until the refurb works have been completed and then see about possible relocation of the bins. Bins are due to be removed by the end of November.

- 19/11-7 LITTLE SALKELD BUS SHELTER
Cllr Addis has an application to apply for funding for a bus shelter from Eden Community Fund. They provide upto 80% of the funding, leaving 20% to find/raise. Winter to get 2 quotes for the work and look at shelter designs.
- 19/11-8 HUNSONBY RED TELEPHONE BOX
Email received from EDC advising the red telephone box in Hunsonby is due to be closed by BT and it can be adopted by the council. Everyone agreed that we would want to adopt it and interest has already been expressed about what to do with. Clerk to email EDC and wait to hear from BT.
- 19/11-9 PLANNING DECISIONS AND APPLICATIONS
19/0738 – Land between Manatee & Beacon View, Little Salkeld.
Residential development for 4 dwellings
Council discussed the above application, various concerns were raised – sewerage, finished design of the houses, village impact. There is a lot of concern within the village about this development and 10 letters have been received by EDC. The case officer is Caroline Brier & she agreed to await our response following the meeting tonight. Cllr Banks EDC advised if we put in an objection, it will go to the Planning committee and a councillor would need to attend the committee meeting. Cllr Addis to write a response from the council.

EDC email received regarding the light in Winskill they are unable to install. Clerk to go back to Amanda Ward at EDC and request site visit. As the village will only have 1 light.
